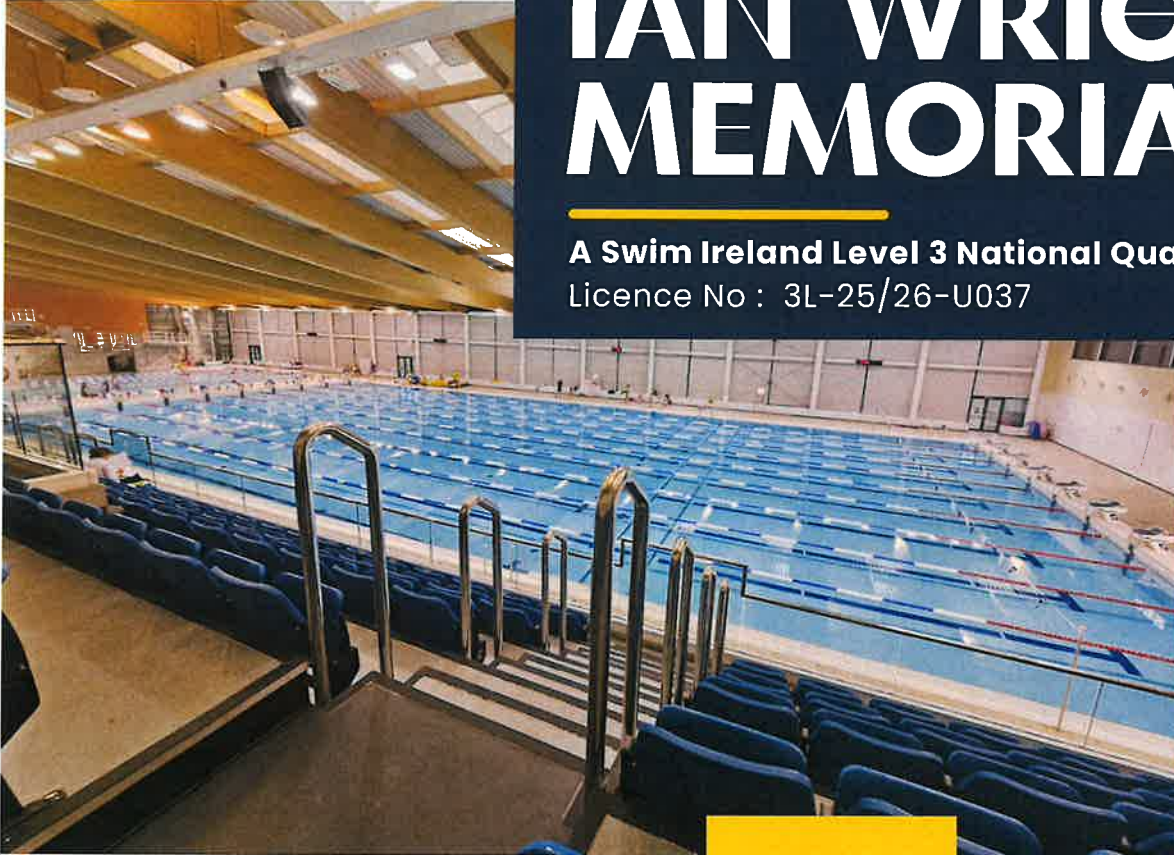

Entry Fee

Entry Times

Please submit Long Course entry times for seeding. HyTek Short course to Long course conversions can be made via the entry file

Age Groups

This is an open competition designated for National and Regional event qualification. There are Four age bands: 11/12yrs (50m & 100m only), 13/14, 15/16, 17+. Age at 31st December 2026.

NO swimmer younger than the above age bands will be permitted to enter. Age at 31st December 2026.

Skins

Top Ten swimmers in 200m Individual Medley Male & Female, Top Ten swimmers in 50m Freestyle Male & Female will qualify to compete in the SKINS event. Prize money of £100 to the winner of each event in SKINS.

SKINS will operate at the end of each session.

Awards

HDW - medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed swimmers in each age category.

Events

All events are HDW. Session times will be confirmed once all entries have been received. BSC reserve the right to return entries should the event be oversubscribed. Clubs will be notified in advance if this is the case. 50m, 100m(11yrs+), and 200m(13yrs+) events in Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle & Individual Medley 400m Freestyle, 400m Individual Medley(13yrs+), 800 & 1500m Free (13+ yrs mixed events - max two heats)

Volunteers

Although Bangor Swimming Club will provide most of the officials during the two day meet, Clubs may be asked to provide officials to assist with the running of the event.

Withdrawals

Any withdrawals, or amendments prior to the first day of the event should be notified to the galaentries@bangorsc.co.uk providing details. Notification for any final withdrawals should be received by no later than 6.00pm on WEDNESDAY 27th May 2026

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1.** The Meet will be held under Swim Ireland and FINA Technical rules. Times achieved at the meet can be used for entry into Regional and National events
- 2.** Entries will be seeded into heats based on entry times with the slowest heat being swum first.
- 3.** Only swimmers, coaches and officials are allowed poolside. Swimmers must have flip flops or shoes on to enter the spectator area.
- 4.** In line with child protection policies, any person wishing to use photographic or video equipment (including mobile phones) are required to sign the authorisation slip at the entry desk. Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any event.
- 5.** The swim down pool will only be available outside Bangor Aurora swim lesson times. Clubs are asked to respect the use of this facility and to use it for its intended use. The Meet organisers reserve the right to withdraw this facility should it be misused
- 6.** All incidents, however minor, must be reported to the meet organisers and/or Venue management, completing all appropriate forms.
- 7.** Swimmers should report to Marshalling Area one event prior to their swim.
- 8.** If the meet is undersubscribed, Bangor SC reserves the right to cancel the meet, in which case all entry fees will be refunded.
- 9.** Neither Bangor SC nor Bangor Aurora Aquatic Centre accept any liability for loss or damage to personal belongings.
- 10.** Bangor SC reserves the right to alter any of the above conditions if necessary. Any matter not covered by the conditions shall be at the promoter's discretion if not covered by Swim Ireland Laws or rules
- 11.** Refreshments may be purchased within the centre operated by Aurora.
